## Appendix 1

Guide to role delineation – Neonatal (9)

Level	Description
Level 1	Post natal care of mothers and babies delivered elsewhere with no complications
Level 2	As Level 1 plus provision of good risk pregnancies and healthy infants of <b>greater</b>
	than 36 weeks gestation
Level 3	As Level 2 plus manages moderate risk pregnancies. Management of <b>babies &gt; 32</b>
	weeks gestation with minimal complications and small babies growing up
Level 4	As Level 3 plus <b>short term assisted ventilator care (&lt; 6 hours)</b> , pending transfer
1	As Local As Local and Control of the Control of Control
Level 5	As Level 4 plus manage <b>high risk pregnancies</b> . Provide all aspects of neonatal
	care including intensive care for the critically ill baby
Level 6	As Level 5 and also provides neonatal surgery and care for complex congenital
	and metabolic diseases of the newborn
